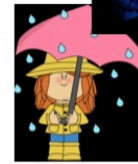

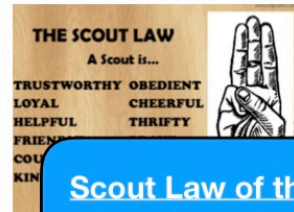


### Pack Needs:
