Scout Law of the Month

Talk about what the scout law means with your child.

Obedient

To be obedient means to follow the rules of our community and of scouting. A big part of being obedient is following the direction of your parents. This includes knowing when it's time to play and when it's time to stop playing and listen to an adult. It also includes following the organizational structure of scouting.

Trustworthy

To be trustworthy means to earn the trust of others by being honest, truthful, and reliable. To be a good friend, one should be trustworthy. In scouting, you can show that your trustworthy by showing up on time to meetings and events and by doing your scout requirements honestly, including wearing your uniform when appropriate.

Cheerful

To be cheerful means to have a good attitude about what you're doing and to stay positive. Cheerful people smile a lot because they understand that they have a lot of reasons to be happy and thankful.
