All-Girls Troop!

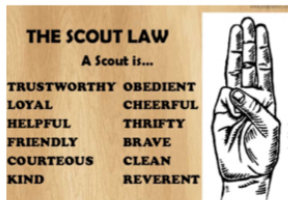

Loyal

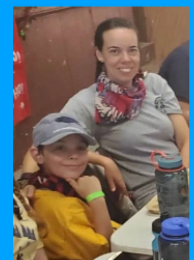
