Friendly

To be friendly means to be inclusive and not tease. It means to

welcome others to be a part of your group and to stick up for those that get picked on. It also means to have good manners and to shake hands when meeting new people.

Time to sell popcorn!

This is the pack's biggest fundraiser. To cover the substantial cost of awards the scouts receive throughout the year, each scout would need to sell about \$180 of popcorn. For now, all sales will be online or to close family and friends.



To get started:

1. Get a Trails End account and app (last year's accounts work). Find the app on your phone's App Store, or text APP to 62771.
2. Start selling in one of the following ways:
 - **Online Direct:** Popcorn is mailed directly to the customers (note: there is a shipping cost). Use the app to e-mail, text, or post a link to the scout's sales page or to take sales directly.
 - **Wagon Sales:** Take orders and later deliver popcorn to customers (safely!). A great option for local family and friends!

Scouts can win Amazon gift cards for earning at least 400 points in sales (\$1 cash = 1 pt, \$1 credit card = 1.5 pts, \$1 online direct sales = 2 pts). If it's safe in the fall, we will have storefront sales. We also can take donations if people want to support our pack that way. More info to follow!
